### Cathy's Melanesian Adventure

In a couple of weeks' time Cathy will be travelling half way around the world for a long-awaited visit to Melanesia: here she shares some thoughts about what she's got to look forward to

Later this month I'm taking a trip to the Solomon Islands, which are part of a vast group of small islands in the South Pacific, known as Melanesia.

The Diocese of Exeter has an historic and active link with the Melanesian Anglican Church.

John Coleridge Patteson, the first bishop of Melanesia was sent out from Devon in 1861.

There are now very many flourishing religious orders in Melanesia which are integral to their local communities. For the last 10 years I have been a Companion/Associate of two Anglican religious orders – the Melanesian Brotherhood and the Sisters of Melanesia. This commitment is offered through prayer and practical help. When members of these communities visit our part of the UK, Companions offer welcome and hospitality. The Archbishop of Melanesia, George Takeli with his wife, June, recently visited the UK, which included a visit to Lee Abbey and Barnstaple. Lee Abbey was the first place that I met some Melanesian Brothers in 2005. Their faith, worship and joy are wonderfully infectious. They play panpipes, dance and sing their worship songs in a uniquely, profound way. I'm now off to meet them in their home setting, staying with the religious communities. I would value your prayers and look forward to sharing some of my experiences.

Cathy will be back home in the UK on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of July: please do pray for her trip, and the people she will meet during her time in Melanesia.
